
Mr Lutfi was accompanied by a number of heads of parliamentary delegations in the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO).

During the meeting, NATO parliamentary efforts and bilateral cooperation areas between NATO's subcommittee and the Shoura Council were reviewed.

He praised the visit, which seeks to enhance bilateral cooperation between the two sides, through consultations and dialogue, to face the rapid developments in the region as well as in the world, in order to best serve the interests of peoples and countries.

Etidal The global Center for combating Extremist Ideology (Etidal) welcomed a distinguished delegation from Belgium, led by The president of the Belgian-Saudi Parliamentary Friendship Committee Mr. Alain Destexhe on a visit. In this visit, the center's plan was discussed regarding fighting terror. The Center's experience, technical and media work to refute and counter extremism were also discussed. The delegation was briefed on the most prominent techniques used in monitoring and analyzing the extremist content and ways of confronting it. In addition, the latest projects that the Center is working on at the moment were presented to the delegation. At the end of the visit, Mr. Alain Destexhe praised the innovative technologies owned by the center, stressing its necessity in combating terrorism. "I have been informed of the terrorist attack that took place in the center of Liege city and the resulting deaths," His Royal Highness the Crown Prince said. "I express to Your Majesty my condemnation of this terrorist act and I extend my condolences to Your Majesty and your friendly people."
