Princess Reema Bandar Al-Saud appointment as Ambassador to the United States

Her Royal Highness Princess Reema bint Bandar bin Sultan has been appointed as ambassador of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques to the United States of America.

Saudi leadership expressed its utmost confidence in women's capabilities. The Kingdom trusts the princess to be the ideal person to further this prized partnership

The first Arab astronaut leads the Kingdom's gaze upon the stars

Prince Sultan bin Salman, chairman of the board of directors of the Saudi Space Commission - and the first Saudi, Arab and Muslim to fly into outer space - has been shaping up the Saudi space program, gathering expertise and forming key partnerships with similar agencies in allied countries.

The Saudi Arabia National Space Agency will set the Kingdom on a path of autonomy to define its satellite and space policies, to better address the goal of peaceful exploration of the outer space, while also implementing a key pillar of the Kingdom's Vision 2030.

Prince Sultan visited the headquarters of the Russian space agency back in April. In a working session with director general Dmitry Rogozin, both sides reiterated the strategic importance of the relationship between the countries. They discussed possible investments in the space sector, as well as joint training programs and shared technological research.

In May, the Saudi Space Commission received the head of the EU Delegation of the European External Action Service to Saudi Arabia, Ambassador Michele Cervone d'Urso. In the meeting, Prince Sultan and the Ambassador discussed scientific exchange and cooperation, especially in the fields of space exploration and communications, between the Kingdom and the EU.



The 9-year-old Najd Al-Maliki is the first gold medallist in the history of Judo for girls in Saudi Arabia. Little Najd won the gold medal for the under-10 category in the Tartao International Judo Competition, which brought more than 350 competitors from five countries to Saudi Arabia.

COMBATting TERRORISM & TERROR FINANCING

The event laid the foundation for a network of education professionals and specialists in studies to combat extremist discourse and violence. It also showcased and compared best practices around the world in combating violence and extremism through education and restructuring of societal values through educational curricula. The OIC established, since 2017, the Sawt Al-Hikma (The Voice of Wisdom) Center, based in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, to counter deviant ideologies and to clarify the true picture of the teachings of Islam.

Conference in Riyadh on the role of education in the prevention of extremism and terrorism

In Riyadh, the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) and the Naif Arab University for Security Sciences (NAUSS) held a joint conference on the Role of Education in Preventing Terrorism and Extremism. The conference presented the efforts of several countries in re-formulating educational curricula to establish values of peaceful coexistence and brotherhood and reject extremism and fanaticism.

In their opening speeches, both HE Dr. Abdulmajeed bin Abdullah Albanyan, president of NAUSS, and HE Dr. Yousef bin Ahmed Al-Othaimeen, Secretary General of the OIC, expressed their appreciation to the Government of Saudi Arabia, the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques, King Salman, and His Royal Highness Prince Mohammed bin Salman, for their financial and moral support in the fight against terrorism at regional and international levels.

In a message to Sri Lankan president Maithripala Sirisena, the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques wrote “We are aware of the terrorist attacks that targeted your friendly country and the resulting deaths and injuries, and we strongly condemn this despicable act of terrorism.”

Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman also expressed his condolences in a message wishing a expedite recovery for those injured in the attacks.

HE Ambassador Saad Alarify signed the book of condolences expressing Saudi solidarity with the people of Sri Lanka and sympathy to the families of the victims.

Working lunch with Arab Heads of Missions

HE Ambassador Saad Alarify held a working lunch with Arab Heads of Missions in honour of Jean-Christophe Belliard.
